Background

Methodology


- Stratified random sample of 670 active voters that voted in at least one election 2010-2015.
 - Enough primary voter interviews were conducted to ensure at least 200 primary voters for each party
- Interviews conducted by telephone June 23-27, 2016
 - To cell and landline phones
- Margin of error of ±3.8% for 670 cases
- Typical interview was about 7 minutes in length

Voter control of gambling in Florida Trial heat of amendment










Who should decide gambling policy in Florida? (four fixed-choice options were offered)

Note: percentages do not add up to 100% due to rounding.










Casino lobbyists have too much influence over elected officials in Florida
